## Labor Market Search and the Business Cycle (Konstanz, Germany 27<sup>th</sup>-29<sup>th</sup> June, 2012)

We invite you to submit a paper for the Search and Matching Workshop: *Labor Market Search and the Business Cycle*. The workshop is to be held in Konstanz, Germany from the 27th till 29<sup>th</sup> June, 2012. Plenary talks will be given by Prof. Jim Albrecht (Georgetown University) and Prof. Fabien Postel-Vinay (University of Bristol and Science Po, Paris).

The workshop has the aim of bringing together high quality papers that deal with (i) wage dispersion and inequality over the business cycle; (ii) worker reallocation and mismatch unemployment; and (iii) firm dynamics, job creation and job destruction.

Both theoretical and empirical contributions are welcome. Each paper presented will be assigned a discussant. We strongly encourage junior academics and advanced PhD students to submit a paper. Thanks to the financial support of the Thyssen foundation and of the Universities of Konstanz and Essex, registration is free and we have a limited budget for lodging and travel expenses.
